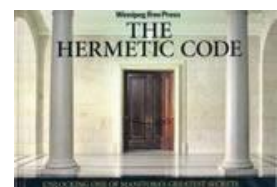

Lower Fort Garry Flashlight Vigils

June 11, July 16, August 13 and September 10

Once again we have been invited by Parks Canada to investigate Lower Fort Garry National Historic Site for the privilege of experiencing their paranormal phenomenon ourselves! For a select few who dare to venture into this site in the dark, we hope to contact some of the astral beings that make this old fort their home. We will explore three buildings over three hours, learning about the history of the site as well as some of the individuals who can go bump in the night. Dowsing and table tipping will be attempted as a means of communicating as well as the use of equipment and tools of the trade, i.e. pendulums, EMF, and digital recording devices. Come and rediscover a different kind of Fort, one seen through the eyes of a spirit!
