At 7:00pm, you meet in the main Rotunda of the Via Rail Station (123 Main St at Broadway Ave). Ghosts, history, paranormal phenomenon, and eyewitness accounts are told at documented haunted buildings throughout Winnipeg that include: The Hotel Fort Garry, the Vaughan Street Jail, Elmwood Cemetery, and many more 'happy haunts' you may be unfamiliar with.

The Haunted Winnipeg Investigates Bus Tour

Are you ready to investigate the paranormal? Are you up to photographing mysterious lights and orbs? See for yourself as you will use video, thermometers, and cameras as you are taken in and shown the actual areas that known orbs, visions, and apparitions appear. Join us at 7:00pm in the main Rotunda of the Via Rail Station (123 Main St at Broadway Ave). Our very own undertaker will make sure we stop and visit inside famous Haunted sites that include: The Legislative Building, the St. Boniface Museum, Elmwood Cemetery, and The Hotel Fort Garry. Learn what it takes to be an investigator while being at the center of the activity!

The two bus tours include:

- Two and one half hour guided ghost tour of Winnipeg
- All transportation by private, air-conditioned, and washroom equipped highway motor coach.
- *Entry at the locations (Via Rail Station, The Legislative Building, St. Boniface Museum, Elmwood Cemetery, Hotel Fort Garry)

*Investigates tour only



The cost per person for either bus tour is:

- \$29.00 + GST + \$1.50 agency fee for adult seats (including seniors, students, and youth)
- \$14.00 + GST + \$1.50 agency fee for children under 12

Seats for both bus tours are non-refundable and non-transferable and must be purchased in advance.

The **Haunted Winnipeg Investigates Bus Tour** is available every Thursday night, in June, July, and August commencing June 4, 2009. In September and October, they run Monday and Thursday nights. The **Historical Haunted Winnipeg Bus Tour** is available Tuesday nights, commencing June 2, 2009. In September and October they run Tuesday and Friday nights.

The bus tours go rain or shine, so please dress appropriately for the weather as you do get off the bus. You are welcome to bring along your camera or any other investigative equipment with you to catch some unusual images.
